Clautiere, Estate Syrah Paso Robles 2004

The Syrah opens with a bouquet of cinnamon and mocha cherry. Soft suede textures, with flavors of black cherry cocoa, tobacco leaf, hints of mint, cassis and clove on the finish.

Four Vines, Kiler Canyon Syrah Paso Robles 2006

On the nose it emanates rich black fruit, provincial herbs and spice. The palate delivers layers of berry fruit, pepper and spice which trail into a silky vanilla oak finish.

Klinker Brick, Farrah Syrah Lodi 2008

This wine has a deep, rich garnet color and shows tobacco, mint and cherries on the nose. Dense silky layers of raspberry and chocolate, smooth finish with hints of earth and spice.
